

FOUNDATIONS

1. God

I believe there is one God, who has revealed Himself as Father; through His Son, in redemption; and as the Holy Spirit, by emanation. Jesus Christ is God manifested in flesh. He is both God and man. I believe He is a gracious God who loves me. (See Deuteronomy 6:4; Ephesians 4:4-6; Colossians 2:9; I Timothy 3:16.)

2. The Bible

I believe the Bible is the infallible Word of God and the authority for salvation and Christian living.

(See II Timothy 3:15-17.)

3. Grace and Salvation

I believe everyone has sinned and needs salvation. Salvation comes by grace through faith based on the atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ. (See Romans 3:23-25; 5:19; 6:23; Ephesians 2:8-9.)

4. The New Birth

I believe the saving gospel is the good news that Jesus died for our sins, was buried, and rose again. We obey the gospel (II Thessalonians 1:8; I Peter 4:17) by repentance (death to sin), water baptism in the name of Jesus Christ (burial), and the baptism of the Holy Spirit with the initial sign of speaking in tongues as the Spirit gives the utterance (resurrection).

(See I Corinthians 15:1-4; Acts 2:4, 37-39; Romans 6:3-4.)

5. Eternity

I believe Jesus Christ is coming again to catch away His church. In the end will be the final resurrection and the final judgment. The righteous will inherit eternal life; the unrighteous, eternal death. I have hope because of His return. (See I Thessalonians 4:16-17; Revelation 20:11-15.)

I honor God with my time, my finances, my talents, and my health. (See Proverbs 3:9; Luke 6:38; Titus 2:7.)

I will worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness, honoring God both inwardly and outwardly.

(See Psalm 96:9; Il Corinthians 7:1; I Peter 1:15-16; Hebrews 12:14; I Corinthians 6:19-20.)





CHARACTER

1. Fruit of the Spirit

I desire to be a fruitful Christian and to let the fruit of the Spirit flourish in my life, revealing to others God's transformative power.

(See Galatians 5:22–23; Il Peter 1:5–9.)

2. Do Justly

God honors those who stand for righteousness and justice. I will choose to do the right thing no matter the situation or the impending consequences. (See Micah 6:8; Proverbs 21:3; I Peter 3:12)

3. Love Mercy

Because Jesus Christ has shown me great mercy, I will be merciful to others. (See Micah 6:8; Galatians 6:1-2)

4. Walk Humbly

I value humility and understand that all good gifts in my life come from God alone. I submit to Him, seek His lordship in my life, and honor others. (See Micah 6:8; I Peter 5:5–7; Colossians 3:12; Ephesians 4:2; II Chronicles 7:14; Romans 12:10.)
